



A care team member may be in contact as we do a yearly review of all medical records to schedule any out-of-date lab work. NRM requires these to be updated once per year as we follow ASRM guidelines in the best interest of patient care. Please see list below for specifics.

For people with the capacity for pregnancy and trying to conceive (i.e., people with a uterus and would like to become pregnant):

The following infectious disease labs are required to be **updated yearly**: Hep B Surface Antigen, Hep B Core Antibody, Hep C, HIV, RPR, and Gonorrhea/Chlamydia.

**Genetic Carrier Screening is recommended for partners that are contributing sperm for fertilization of their partner's egg or donor egg.

Please note, you can decline genetic carrier screening after you have watched the Engaged MD modules and signed the consent declining the test. You will need to let your care team know you declined the test.

Your NRM provide may also recommend other test based on your individual need.
